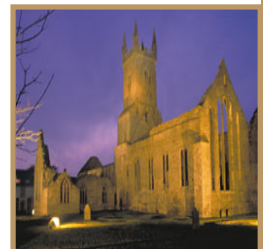


SOUTHWEST OF IRELAND LUXURY GOLF ITINERARY



Day One

Arrive Shannon Airport and pick up your car to transfer to Doonbeg where you will check into **The Lodge** for three nights. Simply stated, The Lodge is extraordinary. Suites are private residences, meant to be a home away from home, and are equipped with everything any type of traveler would require. Each of their suites and cottages are individually designed and decorated so that no two are alike, each consisting of a room with a fireplace, fully equipped kitchen, and differing number of bedrooms. These suites and cottages are perfect for groups of golfers, families or couples traveling together.



Day Two

After breakfast in your hotel, play Doonbeg.



Opened for general play in 2002, Doonbeg Golf Club has taken its place among the great courses of Ireland. This links land remains untouched by time and sits astride the rugged Atlantic coastline. With rolling seaside and grassy dunes rising almost 100 feet above the crashing shoreline, this par 72 course is consistently challenging along its 6,818 yards.

Day Three

After breakfast in your hotel, transfer to and play Lahinch (App. 40 mins).



The origins of Lahinch go back to the closing decade of the nineteenth century when the famous soldiers of the Black Watch Regiment stumbled upon a vast wilderness of dune land two miles from the Cliffs of Moher and today it has become a Mecca for keen golfers, with two of the most famous golf holes in Ireland, “Klondyke” and “Dell”.

Day Four

After breakfast and checking out of your hotel, transfer to and play Ballybunion’s Old Course (Transfer includes 30 minute ferry ride from Killimer to Tarbert. Total transfer time including ferry: 1 hr 20 mins).



The Old Course is deserving of its reputation as one of the fine golf courses in the world. With greens leaving little room for error on each side, the wind becomes a huge factor throughout this course. The challenge comes along around the 8th hole, a testing small par-3 requiring intense accuracy due to the green falling off in all directions, and good luck getting up and down! The 16th par-5 hole is most typical of Ballybunion, with an intimidating tee shot played to a dog-leg with an uphill approach.

Golfers will also have the option to play Ballybunion’s second course, the Cashen.

After golfing Ballybunion, continue on to Killarney. Check into the **Randle’s Court Hotel** where you will be staying for three nights. Ideally located five minutes outside of Killarney Town’s Centre, the Randles Court Hotel is a truly special, privately owned and managed hotel for more than three generations. Tastefully decorated with comfort and elegance, relax and enjoy in front of an open log fire in the Drawing Room, or pass the evening away with your favorite tippie in Wiggs



Day Five

After breakfast in your hotel, transfer to and play Tralee (App. 40 mins).



Tralee Golf Course is the first European course designed by Arnold Palmer, one of the best known sportsmen, and as a professional golfer holds 92 national and international championships. Each experience at Tralee is a new one; golfers must play off the markers designated on the day by the Management of Tralee Golf Club, and must abide by local rules, and follow directions on the course, adding adventure and demanding an ability to adapt to the ever changing circumstances that is the Irish golf experience.

Day Six

After breakfast in your hotel, transfer to and play Killarney's Killeen Course (App. 10 mins).



This par-72 course is 6,566 meters long and is very much the flagship course at the Killarney Golf Club. With fast greens close to water hazards, the Killeen Courses imposing backdrop are the Killarney lakes and high mountain ranges. Accuracy is vital to keep up with the length of this course and with the water hazards on virtually every hole. A fan favorite is the 10th hole where you are virtually playing onto a lake.

Day Seven

After breakfast and checking out of your hotel, transfer to Shannon Airport where you will depart from.

Costs:

Per Person Sharing: £ 1,835

Single Accommodation: £ 1,950

Costs Include:

- Three nights in the Five Star Lodge, Doonbeg
- Three nights in the Four Star Randles Court, Killarney
- Five rounds of golf
- Seven day car rental and ferry transfer

Costs Do Not Include:

- Optional round of golf at Ballybunion's Cashen Course.
